About us

[Green Health Thames Valley](#) is a small charity that provides horticultural therapy support for people with mental health challenges. Operating in our small community garden in Whitley we now require trustees to help us set the strategic direction of the charity. We expect demand for our services to increase as more people struggle with mental health challenges as a consequence of Covid19.

What are trustee's responsibilities?

- Ensure the charity is carrying out its purposes for the public benefit
- Comply with the charity's governing document and the law
- Act in the charity's best interests
- Manage the charity's resources responsibly
- Act with reasonable care and skill
- Ensure the charity is accountable

How much time and commitment is required?

Trustees are expected to attend board meetings every two months, which take place in the early evening for around 90 minutes. Trustees are also expected to take time to carefully review any shared papers ahead of these meetings, e.g. a finance report. Trustees may also take on additional duties, which may be specific to your expertise (e.g. the treasurer will review accounts), or more general, such as contributing to the development of a strategic document. There is an average time commitment of approximately 4 hours a month.

About you

We are particularly interested in hearing from people who have experience in mental health or general medical/health settings, and those from a marketing and fundraising background. Previous trustee experience isn't essential as training is available.

We welcome people from all walks of life with a diverse range of experiences and backgrounds, and look forward to hearing what relevant experiences you may be able to bring to GHTV.
